

Privacy Policy

Introduction

The term 'Eden Digital Labs or Eden Digital Labs Company ("us", "we", or "our")' will refer, until the term is confirmed and approved as a legal entity by legal authorities as intended by, to the legal owner of the service/services binding you with this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy describes how Eden Digital Labs collected, used, shared with others, and otherwise handled Personal Data (defined below) about the following:

- People (will be referred as "Site") who visit our website, mobile applications and other online services
- Liaison authorities of our users and / or potential users
- Suppliers and suppliers providing goods and services to Eden Digital Labs;
- Personal Data of Other People received by Eden Digital Labs.
- In this Privacy Statement, "Personal Data "means any information relating to an identifiable or identifiable natural person (with or without other information stored by Eden Digital Labs).

Overview

Unless otherwise stated, Eden Digital Labs acts as the data responsible for the Personal Data that it is handling, and is therefore obliged to ensure that the systems and the operations it is using are in compliance with the applicable data protection laws.

Eden Digital Labs employees are responsible for complying with this Privacy Statement and other relevant policies regarding the processing of Personal Data and are required to attend the training of personal data protection as appropriate to their duties.

Basic Concepts

Collection: We collect Personal Data from various sources in connection with our business management and business relations.

Usage: We use Personal Data to provide our services and to respond to questions, to manage accounts and to maintain our operations and other commercial and compliance objectives.

Sharing: We share Personal Data to the extent necessary to provide our services and to respond to questions and to achieve their commercial and compliance objectives.

Informing options: You have a number of rights to how we use Personal Data to send you informational messages.

Related person rights: You have the right to access your Personal Data, to request the correction or deletion of your Personal Data and to appeal to the processing of your Personal Data.

Data security: We take the necessary technical and administrative measures to prevent loss, misuse, alteration or accidental destruction of the Personal Data we process.

Data transfer abroad: We provide appropriate protection for data transfer abroad under the conditions specified in the applicable law.

Other matters: Information provided in this Privacy Statement; (i) possible consequences of failure to provide Personal Data, (ii) data retention, (iii) links to third party websites, and (iv) changes to this Privacy Statement.

Personal Data Collection

We collect the Personal Data for Site visitors, Users, potential Users, suppliers and other third parties:

Basic data: Information about family life, including family, children, hobbies and interests (except for private personal data), name, gender, title, organization, job responsibilities, telephone number, postal address, e-mail address and contact information.

Private personal data: In limited circumstances, to the extent that it is necessary for a particular service we provide to you, religious or other beliefs, race or ethnicity, sexual orientation, health data and trade union membership information.

Registration data: Newsletter requests, event and seminar records, nutritional preferences (except for private personal data), subscriptions, download records and user name and passwords.

User service data: Personal Data, billing details, payment history and User feedback from users, customers, employees, or people known to the User.

Information data: Individual participation in conferences and seminars, references and memberships, data on product interests and preferences.

Data on job candidates: Data on job candidates or other job opportunities available to others by our Site or other offline means, which may also be subject to an additional recruitment privacy policy.

Device data: Computer Internet Protocol (IP) address and other data on the use of the Site (Usage Data).

We collect Personal Data from various sources to be directly related persons or Users, employees and publicly available resources. About Employees, Customers or Other Persons If data is obtained from Users, it is the User's responsibility to ensure that such data is transmitted in accordance with the applicable data protection legislation.

Using Personal Data

We use and process Personal Data within the scope of the following purposes and legal grounds:

We use basic data, record data, User service data, and device data to provide a freelance service. These data are processed so that we can fulfill our obligations under our contracts with our Users.

We use basic data, proprietary personal data, registration data, informational data and User service data to manage our business activities and manage our User relationships.

These data are processed so that we can meet our obligations under our contracts with our Users (for example, editing and processing invoices) and our suppliers (managing goods and services supply to Eden Digital Labs). We use device data to make our sites more useful. Within the scope of our legitimate interests, we monitor how our Site is used to help us improve the existing layout and information on our Site and to provide a better service to our Site users.

We use basic data, registration data, transaction data and device data to ensure the security and efficient operation of our sites and information technology systems. As part of our legitimate interests, we monitor how our Sites are used to identify and prevent fraud, other offenses and abuse in our Sites. Through this processing activity, we enable you to use our Sites safely.

In order to provide information services; we use informational data, basic data, proprietary personal data, registration data, User service data, and device data to provide you with information about activities or services that may be of interest to you, including legal services, legal updates, User conferences or networking events. In the context of our legitimate interests, we process these data to provide you with specific and relevant information, updates and invitations.

In order to ensure compliance and fulfill our legal obligations, we use basic data, registration data, transaction data and device data to control the identity of new Users and prevent money laundering and / or counterfeiting. These data are processed to comply with the legal obligations we are subject to.

We use data on business candidates and compliance data to ensure recruitment and service provider management and manage development processes. These data are processed in order to comply with the obligations we are subject to within the scope of the recruitment privacy policy regarding the management of the recruitment and development processes and the legal obligations we are subject to.

Usage of Personal Data

We may share Personal Data with the following buyer categories:

Business Partners: Eden Digital Labs is able to work in cooperation with globally operating companies and solution partners. We may share Personal Data with our business partners abroad to provide you with the best consultancy services and to manage our relationship with you, or to the extent necessary for the purposes described above.

Suppliers and service providers: We share Personal Data with suppliers and service providers to enable our suppliers and service providers to operate in accordance with our guidelines and instructions for the fulfillment of the purposes above. Among the suppliers and service providers we serve; infrastructure and electronic communications service providers, including service providers for our user retrieval system, financial systems, and User relationship management databases; third-party consultants and conferences that support us for business analytics and information activities, as well as providers of venues where we host events. These individuals are obliged to provide appropriate level of security for Personal Data and to use and process such Personal Data only on our behalf under the terms of the contract we sign.

Financial institutions: We share Personal Data with financial institutions in order to carry out billing and payment transactions.

Recruitment companies: In the event that Eden Digital Labs is subject to transactions such as mergers, acquisitions, transfers of assets, transfer of services to another provider, or insolvency, is subject to bankruptcy or liquidation processes, or share with a potential buyer.

Mandatory disclosures and legal claims: We share Personal Data in order to comply with the requirements of regulatory authorities or public authorities or any legally applicable request or any subpoena, court order or other legal request. We also share Personal Data to protect our legal rights, property rights and security or the rights, rights and security of others, or to protect against legal claims.

Informational Messages

If we process your Personal Data for the purpose of sending you information messages, you have the right to control the processing activity. You may choose not to receive such communications at any time by following the relevant directions or by contacting us as described below.

Related Person Rights

You have the following rights regarding the processing of your Personal Data:

Access: Subject to certain exceptions, you have the right to request a copy of the Personal Data we process about you in electronic form. If you make such a request, we may ask you to prove your identity before providing this information to you. If you request multiple copies of Personal Data, we may charge you a reasonable fee. Revision: You have the right to request the correction of missing or incorrect Personal Data that we process about you.

Delete: You have the right to request that we delete Personal Data that we process about you unless we have to retain this data to fulfill our statutory obligation or create, fulfill or defend a legal claim.

Limitation of processing: You have the right to request the restriction of the processing of your Personal Data in the cases listed here; (i) the data we process about you are not up to date, (ii) the transaction is unlawful, or (iii) we do not have the possibility of deleting the data or deleting your data due to a legal or other obligation despite the fact that the data are not processed.

Data portability: You have the right to request that we transmit Personal Data that we process about you to another data responsible for you in the situations listed here; (i) the data provided to you by you, or (ii) to process such data on your consent or to fulfill our contractual obligations (such as providing legal services).

Objection: If we process your Personal Data within the scope of our legitimate interests, you have the right to object to this transaction, depending on your particular situation. If our legitimate interests do not prevail over your rights and interests, or if we do not need

to continue to process the data for the creation, fulfillment or defense of a legal request, we will fulfill your request.

Revocation of consent: If you have consented to process our Personal Data, you have the right to withdraw your consent free of charge at any time. You may also use this right if you do not wish to receive any other informational messages from us. However, pursuant to Law No. 6698 on the Protection of Personal Data;

- (a) learning whether any personal data is processed;
- (b) requesting information regarding the processing of your personal data;
- (c) learning the purposes of processing your personal data;
- (d) learn these individuals if personal data has been transferred to third parties in the country or abroad;
- (g) to require Eden Digital Labs to ensure that third parties authorized by Eden Digital Labs, who process personal data, respect your rights under this section;
- (h) objecting to the adverse consequences of personal data generated by automated systems;
- (i) you have the right to claim damages if you incur losses due to unlawful processing of your personal data.

International Data Transfer

We may share your information, including your Personal Data, with our business partners abroad to respond to your needs or if necessary for the purposes described above. It is also necessary to protect the personal data of Eden Digital Labs or other persons in limited circumstances, the need for the sale or transfer of part or all of the work, or the legal or administrative requirements, or the We can share with. When we need to share your personal data in this context, we will make every effort to inform you before sharing, unless it is legally prohibited or information is not possible.

Other Issues

- (i) How do you achieve results if you do not provide your Personal Data?

You do not have to provide all personal data contained in this Privacy Statement to use our Website or otherwise communicate with us, but if you do not provide certain personal data, we may not be able to respond to your claims in full or provide some of our services.

- (ii) How long do we hold personal data?

We keep the Personal Data we process for the posting of informational messages as long as you have the consent to receive such messages. We delete such data in accordance with your request and in accordance with the legislation in force. For other purposes, we keep the data we collect and process in accordance with the data retention policies and practices in force during the period stated in this Privacy Statement or otherwise.

(iii) Does this Privacy Statement apply to other websites?
